Birthday Blues

"Big Daddy" Lester Kinsey

(March 18, 1927, Pleasant Grove, MS - April 3, 2001, Gary, IN)

Big Daddy Kinsey began singing at a young age in the church where his father, who was the preacher, did not like him singing blues. In 1944, at age 17, Lester moved north to Gary, Indiana to work in the steel mills. He married Christine McNeal in 1946. After serving in the military, he returned to the steel mills to support his growing family. Big

Daddy began to play music again and picked up the guitar in the late 60's while performing on harmonica with The Soul Brothers. Big Daddy started a family band with his three very talented sons: Donald Kinsey-guitar (5/12/1953 - 2/6/2004), Ralph Kinsey-drums (4/26/1952 - 1/17/2024)) and Kenneth Kinsey-bass (1/21/63). Donald and Ralph were only 12 and 13 when they joined Big Daddy Kinsey & His Fabulous Sons. Later Donald played and toured with Albert King and then Bob Marley but returned to Gary IN in 1984 to form The Kinsey Report with Pinetop Perkins on piano. Big Daddy also ran a bus charter company, Kenites Coach Lines, that took groups to casinos in the south.

And I Ain't Lyin'!

Sugar left Up North's nonstop snow and arctic cold behind as she drove south to Memphis, TN for 5 days of Blues at the **Blues Foundation's 41st IBC's - International Blues Challenge** where over 20 clubs hosted Blues Society Blues Bands competing against each other on Beale St. The first order of business was for Sugar to go straight to Schwab's where she was looking for a John de Conqueror root mojo bag but upgraded and got the "everything" mojo bag that seemed to start working immediately! Congratulations to the first place IBC band winner: **Derrick Dove & the Peacekeepers** and Derrick Dove also won Best Blues Guitarist! For the first place IBC solo/duo was **The Weary Ramblers**. Sugar also enjoyed attending the **KBA's - Keeping the Blues Alive** luncheon where she sat at the **NOLA Blue** records table with **Benny Turner** and **Sallie Bengtson** who was honored with a KBA. Afterwards Sugar attended one of the many workshops: the Youth Workshop with hostess **Danielle Nicole Schnebelen-Miller** joined by her husband **Brandon Miller**, plus **Jim Pugh** and **Kevin Burt**.

Next stop was Clarksdale's **Shack Up Inn** (that is for sale!) where she met

Randy Sepalla aka "Da Bones Man" who lives nearby until May 1st when he moves back to the UP. Playing rhythm bones is one of the oldest African and Irish traditional instruments that have been handed down over the generations. Also, the Da Bones Man makes custom wearable washboards. Sugar saw **Keith Robinson** at Clarksdale's **Ground Zero**, who she saw on tour with **Morgan Freeman's Symphonic Blues** last August in NYC's Central Park. From Macon, **Cash's Juke Joint - Angel "Cash" Ocasio, Jr**, who was a top 10 finalist for the **2026 Best Self-Produced CD** was at **Bluesberry Cafe** for the 3rd Annual IBC After Party Jam that he hosted.

Sugar left at dawn from the Shack Up to continue down Highway 49 - **The Emmitt Till Memorial Highway** that was dedicated in 2005 to the 14-year-old who was lynched in 1955. Today the KKK continues to vandalize memorial signs especially ones near the Tallahatchie River where Emmett Till's body was found. The **Emmett Till Interpretive Center** has replaced the signs many times.

Speaking about the KKK and their continued hate crimes, Sugar went deep into the woods to find **Mississippi John**

Hurt's home that was converted to a museum but was burned down in 2024 and two memorial markers were shot at, torn down and stolen. Due to generous donations the Mississippi John Hurt

Foundation is rebuilding the museum and both memorial markers have been recovered. For more information visit www.msjohnhurtfoundation.org. Sugar made it to Pensacola Beach
